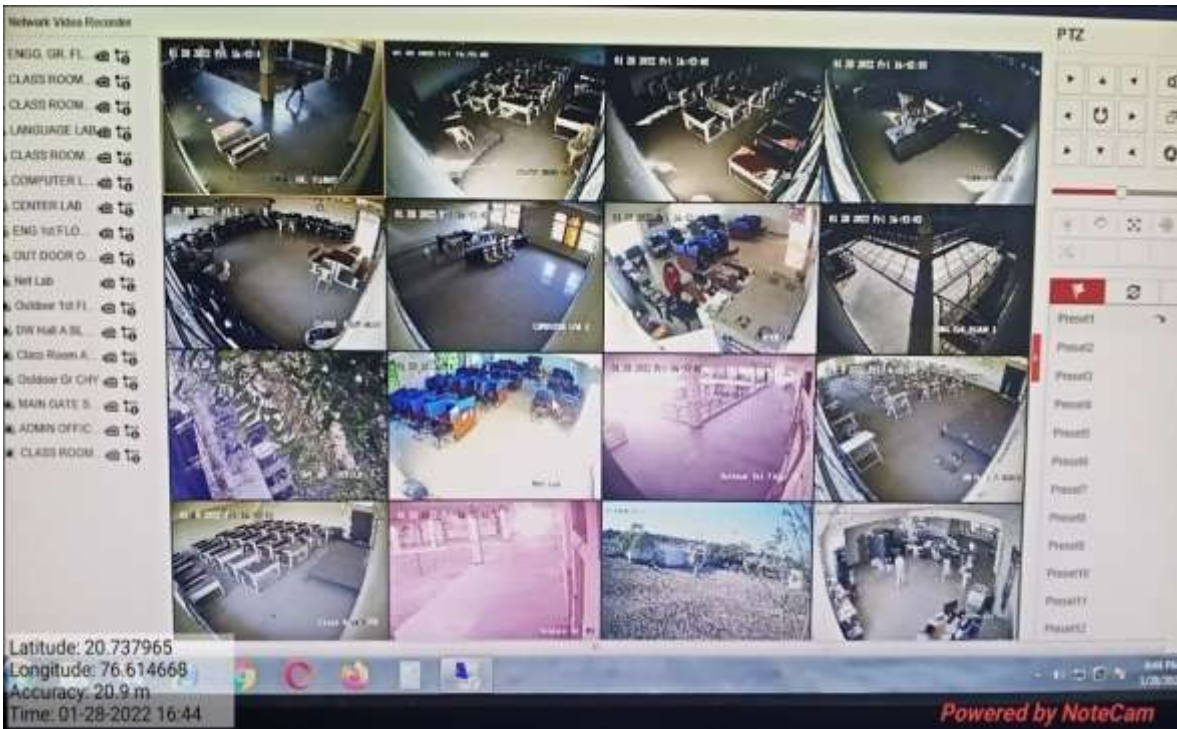
#### Safety and Security Measures in the Campus:-

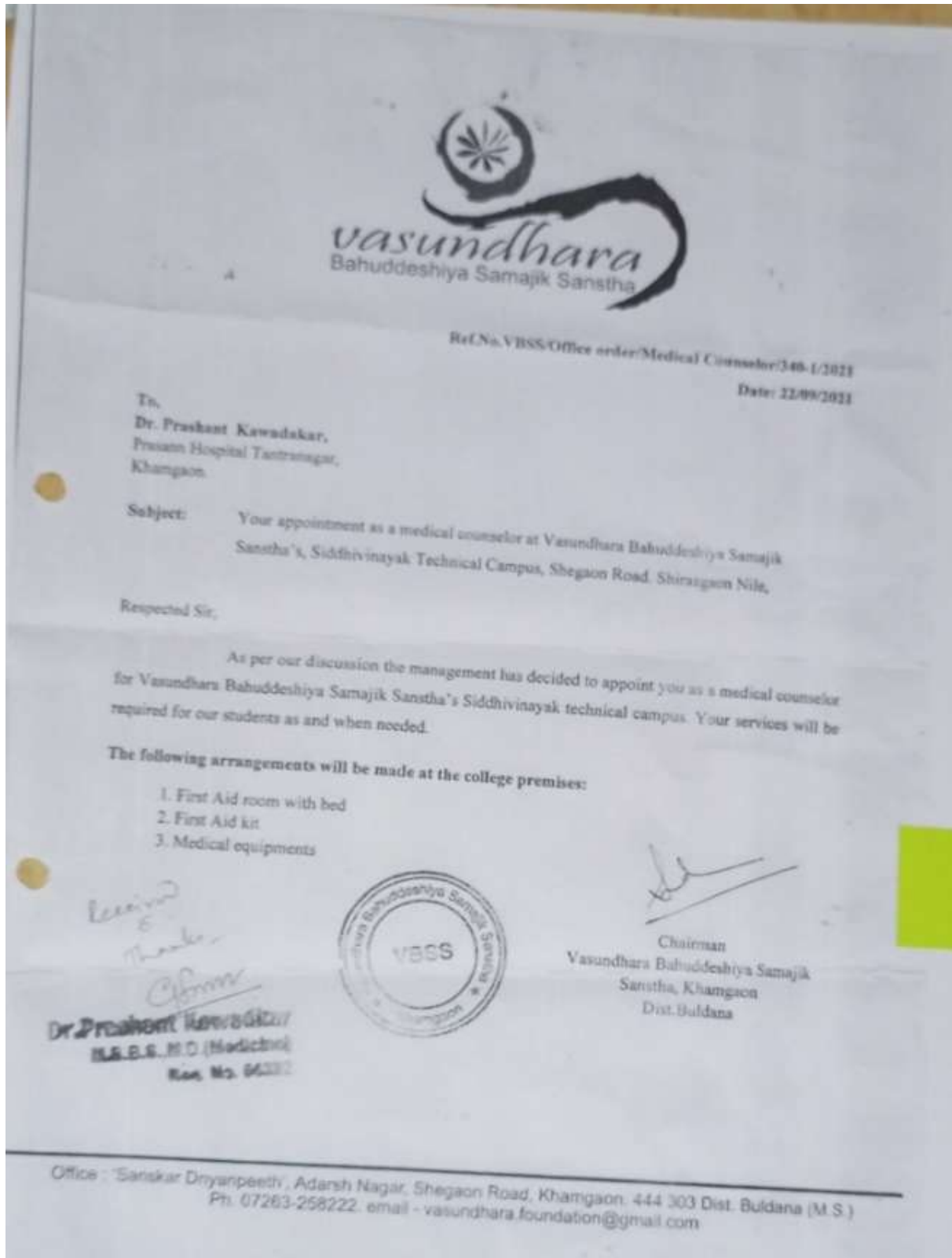
